Biblical Text: Psalm 17:1-15 NIV

1 Hear, O Lord, my righteous plea; listen to my cry. Give ear to my prayer-- it does not rise from deceitful lips. **2** May my vindication come from you; may your eyes see what is right. **3** Though you probe my heart and examine me at night, though you test me, you will find nothing; I have resolved that my mouth will not sin. **4** As for the deeds of men-- by the word of your lips I have kept myself from the ways of the violent. **5** My steps have held to your paths; my feet have not slipped. **6** I call on you, O God, for you will answer me; give ear to me and hear my prayer. **7** Show the wonder of your great love, you who save by your right hand those who take refuge in you from their foes. **8** Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings **9** from the wicked who assail me, from my mortal enemies who surround me. **10** They close up their callous hearts, and their mouths speak with arrogance. **11** They have tracked me down, they now surround me, with eyes alert, to throw me to the ground. **12** They are like a lion hungry for prey, like a great lion crouching in cover. **13** Rise up, O Lord, confront them, bring them down; rescue me from the wicked by your sword. **14** O Lord, by your hand save me from such men, from men of this world whose reward is in this life. **15** And I--in righteousness I will see your face; when I awake, I will be satisfied with seeing your likeness.
